Vague warranty terms ("2 years...maybe")

No local service centers

Inventory "available tomorrow" (means they're probably middlemen)

The gold standard? Look for distributors offering:

- On-site performance testing
- Bulk purchase rebates
- Croatian-language technical support

Solar Solutions for Dalmatian Coast Hotels

Take Hotel Marjan in Split - they cut generator costs by 67% using solar boxes from Rijeka-based SunBalkan. Their procurement chief told me: "We thought solar power box wholesale prices were too high initially. But factoring in EU green subsidies and fuel savings, ROI came in under 14 months."

Now here's where it gets interesting: Their supplier used Croatia's Temporary Crisis Framework (energy tax breaks) to offer 0% VAT deals. This kind of creative financing separates savvy distributors from...

B2B Purchasing Patterns in 2023

Croatian businesses bought 23% more solar units in Q2 than same period last year. But get this - average order sizes shrank from 82 to 54 units. Why? More SMEs entering the market who can't commit to container-load purchases.

Smart wholesalers are adapting with:

- o Flexible MOQs (minimum order quantities)
- o Mixed-pallet options
- o Rent-to-own programs
